Police Response Area Redistricting began January 1, 2007. Our area increased in size but gained 11 officers. The community is now in one district. There have been a couple of home break-ins within the community. Keep an eye on your neighbor's home.

On March 22, 2007 there will be a public meeting regarding the new district plan. The police department is seeking your input. Plan on attending the meeting.

There was a prostitution sting operation on December 7, 2006. Five exclusions were issued, two were repeat offenders. The exclusion zone is working.

- Police Re-districting began January 1, 2007. Our community is now unified under one response area. The district gained 11 officers. There were two home break-ins in the neighborhood – watch your neighbor's house for suspicious activity
- New shopping center "Shops at Westerly Hills Station" to have 22,000 square feet of retail space, Leasing by GVA Lat Purser & Associates 704-519-4200. The center is under construction now.
- Westwood Apartments were being burned as a training exercise by the Charlotte Fire Department. After complaints about the smoke, the burning portion of training has ceased. Ladder and rescue training will continue.
- Spring Festival tentatively planned for April 7, 2007
- "National Night Out" is August 7, 2007
- "Community Clean Up" May 19, 2007 – Looking for volunteers
- Fall Festival & Car Show tentatively planned for September 29, 2007
- Project Safe Neighborhood meets at Bette Rae Thomas center on the first Thursday of each month. Please attend if you can.
- Community is trying to get another grant. This one will be for community signs.
