Highlights from our last meeting

February 21, 2006

City Councilman Warren Turner spoke to the community about development in the 'new Westside'. Changes to look for:

1. The out parcels at the Wal-Mart are being finished. Look for many new businesses in the coming months.
2. The city is looking at moving the school bus storage facility across from Wal-Mart to a new location.
3. Southern Steel and Engineering is for sale, no buyers yet.
4. A new market rate apartment complex is being built on land located directly behind Wal-Mart.
5. Announcement of "Wesley Village" a new mixed use development to be built at Thrift Road and Freedom Drive. There will be hundreds of condos and office space all along the Greenway.

New Business

- Capital improvements to our neighborhood will begin in June 2006. More details will be provided at an upcoming meeting. Charlotte city engineering will be there to answer all your questions.
- Construction has begun on the new YMCA on West Boulevard

- Public Safety Report from Officer Norma Penix –
 1. There were 129 calls to service in the past 12 months as compared to 214 calls for the year before; a significant reduction.
 2. Thirty-three individuals have been excluded from our Prostitution Exclusion Zone. Twelve have pending court cases and fourteen have been convicted and are actively excluded.
 3. New police Captain Doug Gallant is very motivated for police to be proactive in enforcement and within the community.
 4. “Home Security Survey” Call any of the community officers and they will come to your house and give you suggestions to make your home less likely a target for burglary.
