CharMeck Call & Send Program

Brandi, with Charlotte Mecklenburg Sanitation Department, explained the Call and Send Program offered by her department.

This program was established in 2005 to assist communities with trash removal. An officer with the sanitation department canvasses neighborhoods and calls in special pick-ups when needed. They also send a letter to the homeowner in an effort to educate them on the process of calling for special services. Should homeowner/tenants not cooperate, a Code Enforcement officer may be called in to fine the owner/tenant. This is a last resort and the purpose is to educate the community to just call and schedule a pick-up. The city will pick-up just about any trash and debris.
