CATS Enhanced Bus Service

By next Spring, CATS new enhanced bus service will be in place along Morehead and Wilkinson Blvd. This is designed as an express service to the airport from the transportation center uptown.

The new service will feature stops with a higher level of amenities, public artwork at each stop, a new and dedicated fleet of buses, and a wait time of only 15 minutes. The service will have fewer stops than a traditional bus route and will be 'branded' to distinguish it from standard bus service. The current names being considered are Dash and Sprinter.

This line is funded, the artist has been selected, and cost proposals are being reviewed.
