CATS Enhanced Bus Stop Artwork

Tejoula Turner is the artist charged with designing the artwork which will be a part of the new enhanced bus line stations scheduled to be opening summer 2009.

She was seeking information and ideas to incorporate into her designs at each station along the line. In the past, the artwork has been created in tiles, concrete pavers, and images in glass.
